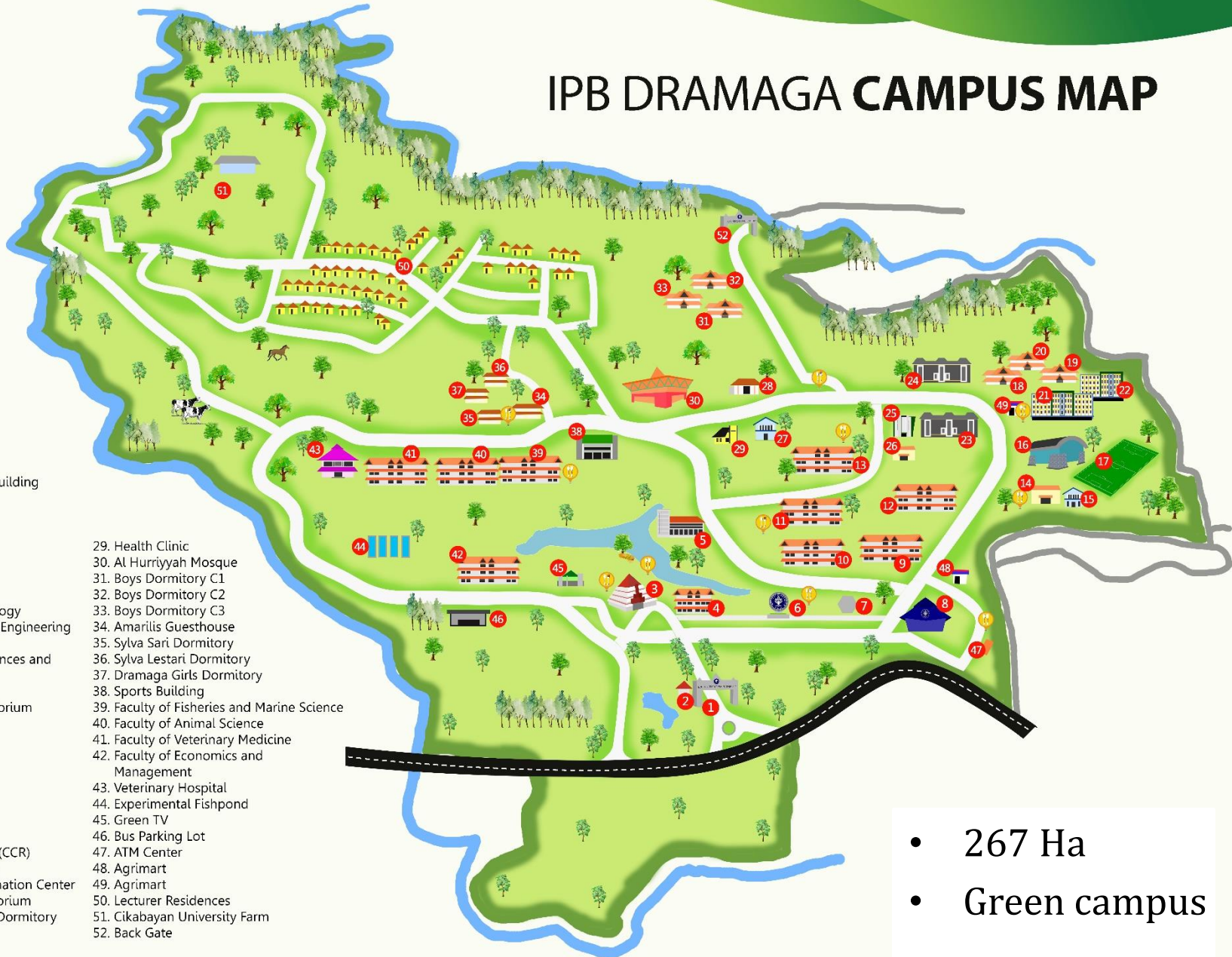

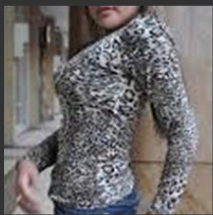


# Student Code of Conduct – Personal Appearance

Legal Basis : Article 4, Rector Decree No. 13/I3/KM/2015, 27 April 2015

Every student is **prohibited** to :

- a. Dress impolitely in the academic activities or other activities in IPB campus.
- b. Impolite dress as stated in point (a) can be defined as **tight and/ or transparent shirt, collarless t-shirt, tank top, hipster, mini skirt, backless, short pants, legging, ripped jeans, sandal, and slipper** in the campus.
- c. Each male student is prohibited to be **long-haired**.
- d. Each student is prohibited to have **punk** and/ or **skinned hair-style**.

# Student Code of Conduct – Academic Activities

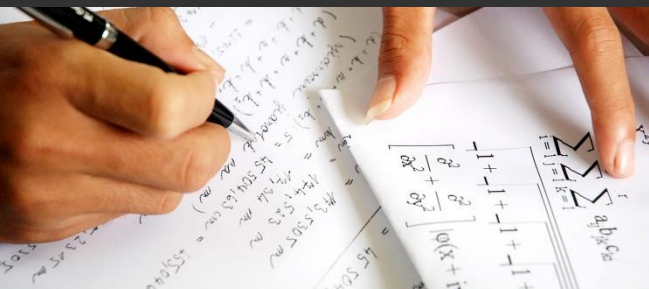
Legal Basis : Article 6, Rector Decree No. 13/I3/KM/2015, 27 April 2015
