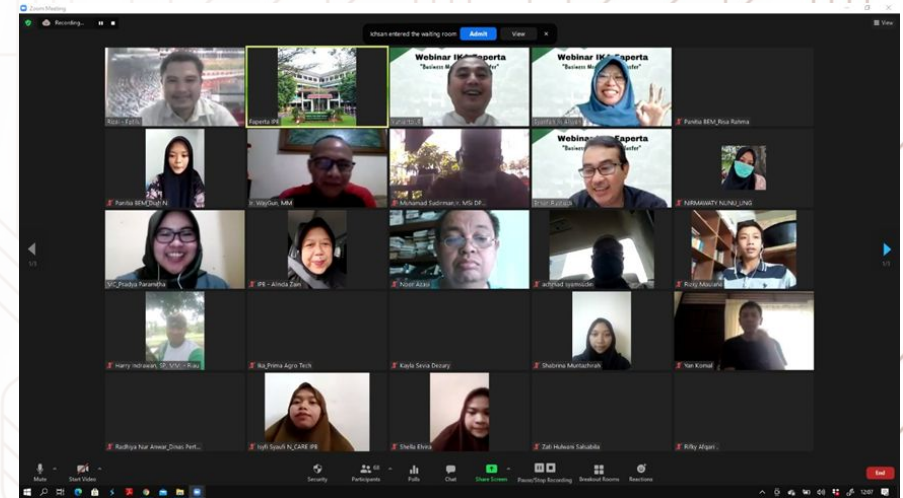

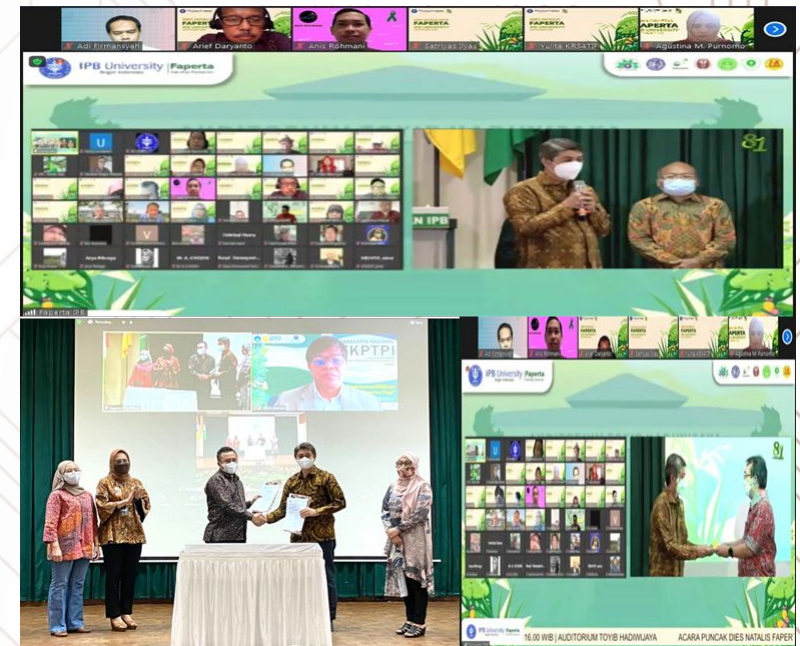

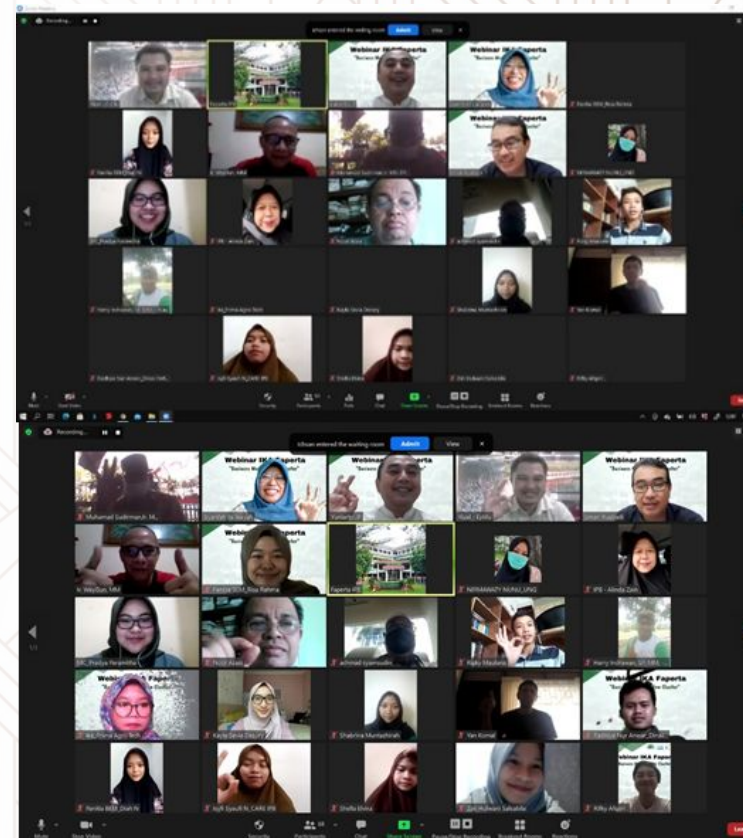
1. Providing scholarships for students

Faperta IPB Alumni Family Association Holds Webinar with Millennial Farmers

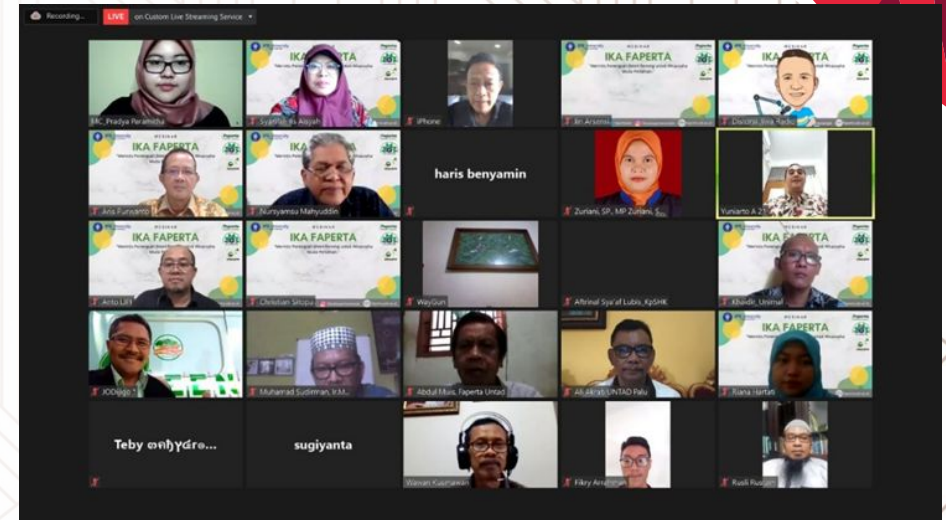

Business Rally Incubator (Bright Cube)

Bright Cube Program for Indonesian Students Micro Credentials (KMMI) in 20210 is a collaboration program between the Management Department, Faculty of Economics and Management with Main Partner PT Teman Muda Berkarya, LRT city Sentul, this collaboration has been initiated since December 2020 and started its first program in January to April 2021 for Bright Cube 1, so KMMI is a business incubator program the second held for the project management course (MAN314). In this Bright Cube KMMI program, students get funding of IDR 400,000 per child which is used to carry out remote businesses, both building their own brand and also in collaboration with brand partners. Bright Cube's brand partners in this program are Ponds and Glow and lovely from PT Unilever Indonesia Tbk, Berkah chicken, JBL Desound, Dropshipaja.com, Hody id and PT Paragon Technology and Innovation. A total of 279 students were divided into 55 business groups and underwent lectures for a total of 20 meetings with both IPB academics and practitioners, Business Mentoring from brand partners and practitioners, initial and final elevator pitching, and weekly founders meetings also carried out online selling business programs. A total of 57 businesses. The student business managed to generate a total turnover of IDR 222,629,317 and a business profit of IDR 76,238,602

Softskill Training and Character Development Self

The Professional Association of Agribusiness Interested Students (Hipma) and the Agribusiness Department of IPB University held Soft skill Training and Personal Character Development "Character Building Training", (1/8). Islamic Economics Winter Course (IESWC)

The Islamic Economics Winter Course 2021 involved 15 expert speakers both from within and outside the country. The number of domestic speakers was 9 people who came from IPB, Airlangga University, UIN Syarif Hidayatullah Jakarta, STEI SEBI, National Amil Zakat Agency (BAZNAS), and Indonesian Waqf Board (BWI). Meanwhile, 6 foreign speakers came from King Abdulaziz University, Istanbul Sabahattin Zaim University, Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University, Islamic Development Bank, EthisCrowd, and Mercy Mission UK.

The IESWC 2021 activity was attended by 251 participants, consisting of 179 domestic participants and 72 overseas participants. Domestic participants were dominated by participants from IPB, while overseas participants were dominated by participants from Universiti Malaysia Terengganu and International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). In general, IESWC 2021 participants come from 14 countries, namely Brunei, Malaysia, Philippines, Gambia, Algeria, Morocco, Nigeria, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Yemen, Somalia, Sri Lanka, India, and Indonesia. IESWC 2021 participants are not only academics, but also professionals.

Prajurit Muda (Young Warrior): Social Impact from Student

Young Soldier is a social laboratory for students to apply their knowledge and knowledge to make a real social impact. The Ministry of Social Affairs organizes this program. Through this 20 credits program, students are challenged to learn from residents and collaborate with local governments, community leaders, local religious leaders, and all social stakeholders in the region. Students go directly to areas that need help. Students will collaborate (internship) at the Ministry of Social Affairs to support their program. Together with the Ministry of Social Affairs, students design and implement social programs relevant to the region, and students will also design digital campaigns to support the social programs that are run. Achievement students can find out that there are still many economic problems, create programs that aim to alleviate poverty by making community empowerment programs, especially for the elderly and the poor, students assist the ministry in the process of verifying and validating social assistance data which is indeed a social assistance program (bansos). It is not as easy as students think. Things in the field are complicated. This is a lesson for students in dealing with society. Students successfully carried out this activity from October 25 – to December 20, 2021.

The entrepreneurship program is the main program in the Department of Forest Products (DHHT) of the Faculty of Forestry and Environment, IPB, which aims to improve student entrepreneurial literacy and competence. This program is implemented through courses containing entrepreneurship, namely Business and Marketing of Forest Products, and student entrepreneurship startup programs. Forestpreneur is DHHT's flagship program to develop student entrepreneurship. This program includes activities to generate entrepreneurial interest through workshops, followed by startup assistance programs and entrepreneurial assistance. The implementation of the Forestpreneur program in collaboration with partners, namely the Creative Industry and Information Technology Society (MIKTI), will be implemented starting in the 2021/2022 academic year.

AgIR Webinar and AGLive Launch Indonesia

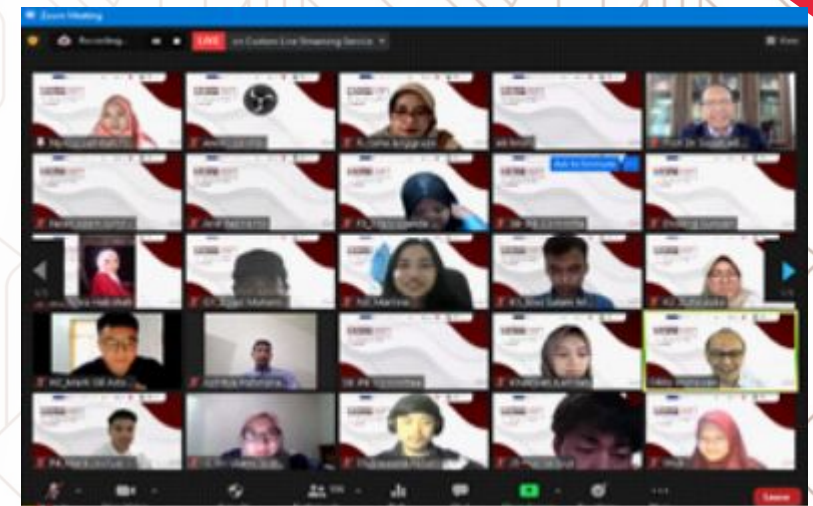

Business Incubator

In collaboration with Incubacel (business practitioners), the business school conducts the SB IPB Entrepreneurship MBKM Program in the form of acceleration for students who are interested in entrepreneurship to develop their business ideas into validated and scaled-up businesses. These activities are in the form of assisting students in developing their business by providing advice and consultancy input in business practices, providing direction in conducting business pitching, and providing an assessment of activity reports. This entrepreneurial activity starts on September 1-14, 2021, and is attended by 79 participants. The program options include the Direct to Consumer (D2C) Business Initiative, the Digital Platform Based Startup Initiative, and the Local Heroes Business Initiative.

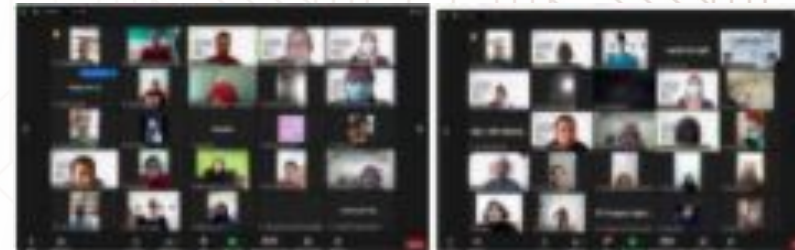
Halal Supervisor Training and Competency Test Batch 1-6 2021

Article 24 of Law No.33 of 2014 concerning Halal Product Guarantee states that a company must have at least one halal supervisor. In line with this, the Halal Product Assurance Organizing Agency (BPJPH), as the authority for organizing halal certification activities, requires companies to have competent and certified halal supervisors when they will carry out halal certification of their products. In order to support efforts to increase competent human resources in the implementation of the halal production process, HSC IPB carries out Halal Supervisor Training and Competency Test activities following SKKNI No. 215 of 2016. The Competency Test is carried out by LSP MUI, which has obtained a license from BNSP to certify the profession of halal supervisor. This training can also be recognized as external training to fulfill the 11 criteria of the Halal Assurance System (SJH).



16 External Training of the Halal Assurance System for MSME Actors

Article 24 of Law No.33 of 2014 concerning Halal Product Guarantee requires every business actor, including Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), to have a halal certificate. This obligation will soon be fully realized, so MSME actors must immediately carry out halal certification. Through Lecturers, the Halal Science Center (HSC) of LPPM IPB serves the community by conducting Halal Assurance System (SJH) Training activities for MSME actors. This activity helps MSMEs understand halal certification procedures in Indonesia and prepares for halal product certification by BPJPH and LPPOM MUI. This activity is open to the public, especially for SMEs, and is carried out online through the Zoom Meeting App.

17 SKKNI-Based SKKNI-Based Sacrificial Animal Handling Webinar during a Pandemic

Sacrifice is one of the unique acts of worship for Muslims. A perfect sacrifice if the whole process has complied with Islamic law. The slaughter of sacrificial animals often does not follow Islamic law, especially in the slaughtering process, which can decrease the quality of the sacrificial meat. This provision has been stated in the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture No. 114/PERMENTAN/PD.410/9/2014 2014. Based on incidents that are still frequently encountered, many people still do not fully understand the proper and correct handling of Qurbani, starting from the slaughtering process to handling the qurban meat, so that indirectly The quality of the sacrificial meat that will be distributed to the community has decreased. In the Serving Lecturer activity, HSC LPPM IPB held sacrificial training activities, hoping that the community knew theory and practice regarding the selection of sacrificial animals, requirements for sacrificial animals, how to slaughter sacrificial animals, and calculation of carcass and sacrificial meat. This activity is carried out online through the Zoom Meeting Application.

20 Technical Guidance and Certification for MSME Facilitators

Bimtek (Technical Guidance) for MSME candidates and assistants is carried out in training, followed by a competency test to determine whether the mentor is competent or not as an MSME mentor. The Bimtek materials include Applying Occupational Health Principles to Control Occupational Safety and Health (K3) Risks, Identification of Problems and Analysis of MSME Assistance Needs, Making MSME Assistance Plans, IPB's Experience in Assisting MSMEs, Coaching Programs, Mentoring Program Workshops, Application of Basic Business Management Micro and Small Business Profile Making Business Plan Preparation, Mentoring Program Workshop, Implementation of Basic Management of Micro and Small Business Management, Business Profile Making Business Plan Preparation, Business Financial Report Preparation, Business Feasibility Preparation, Access to Financing. There is always an independent assignment that participants must collect and present in each material session. This method is used to determine the depth of mastery of the material by participants and mastery of skills to become a candidate for mentoring SMEs.

The certification process is carried out by assessing the collection of independent assignments, skill portfolios, and interviews.

This program was launched by the Directorate of Partnership and Alignment of Business and Industry, Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology of Indonesia.

Head of the Implementation Team of activities at IPB University's Vocational School, Dr. Dahri Tanjung, explained that the program to strengthen the entrepreneurial ecosystem was carried out in order to overcome the limitations of job opportunities and must create new businesses. He admitted, this strengthening was carried out through student activities with an integrated increase in entrepreneurship. The activities in question are in the form of learning activities, business and industrial partnerships (DUDI) with curriculum, and internship boot camps with DUDI Partners such as coaching clinics.

"This activity was launched to open up job opportunities and become one of the problem solvers to solve unemployment increase since COVID-19 pandemic", he said.



Discuss Tax Digitalization, Tax Center of IPB University Vocational School Held a National Webinar Tax Care 2021

For the third time, the Tax Center of IPB University Vocational School held a national webinar Tax Care with the Directorate General of Taxes West Java III. This webinar brought "Tax Digitalization to Optimize Nation and Region Income" as the theme, 16/9. Lala Krisnalia, SE, MM as the Functional Officer of Young Expert Tax Counselor in Directorate General Regional Office West Java III attended as the speaker. She explained the material called "Tax Digitalization Optimize Nation Income".

"Tax Digitalization has been implemented since 2002. By the launching of E-SPT (Electronic Announcement Letter), the taxpayer (WP) can report the announcement letter online. Then it was followed in 2007 by the launching of ERegistration. There is E-Filling in 2012, EBilling in 2014, E-Invoice in 2015. And EBupot in 2018," She said. Meanwhile, another speaker, Ir H Deni Hendana MSi, head of regional revenue agency (Bapenda) Bogor raised a topic called "Local Tax Management Digitalization of Bogor City".

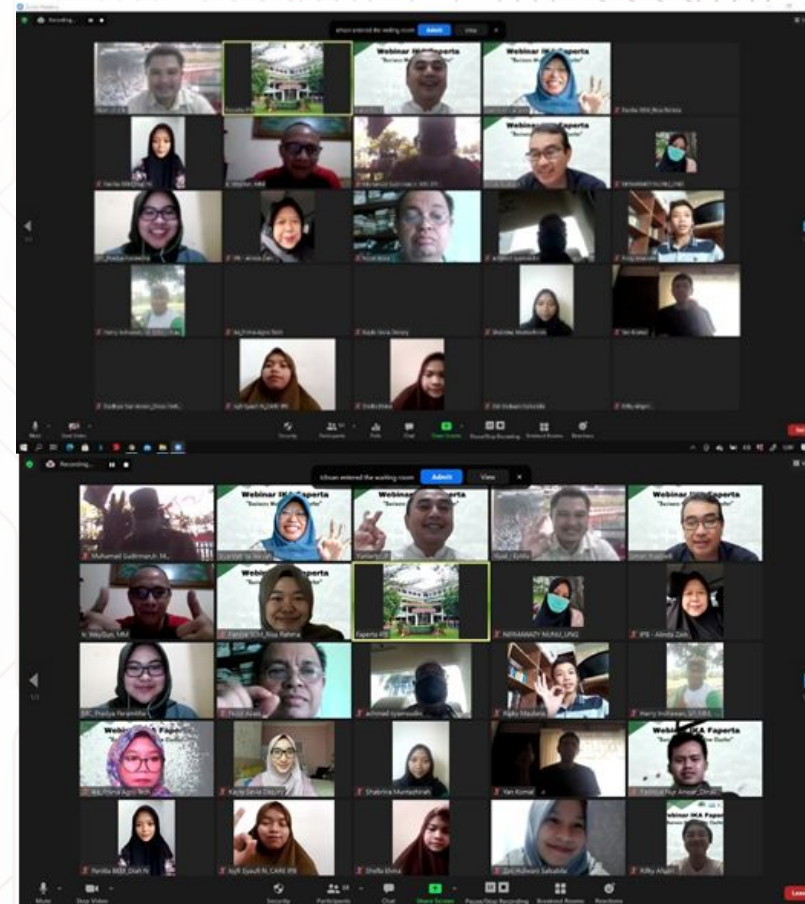

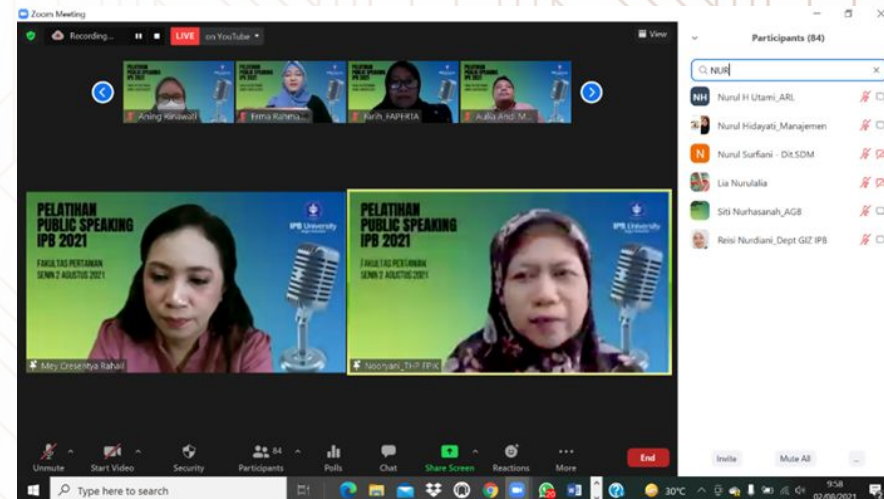

Dissemination of Research Results on Tax Potential of the Palm Oil Plantation in Central Sulawesi

This study uses a remote sensing-based approach to determine the cover and status of oil palm plantations in Central Sulawesi. Data on the cover and status of oil palm plantations are used to calculate Land & Building Tax (PBB) and Value Added Tax (VAT) based on the productive area of oil palm plantations. These results are needed to determine the tax potential of palm oil investment in Central Sulawesi Province. The purpose of this activity is to convey the results of the Research on Estimating Tax Potential for Palm Oil Plantations in Central Sulawesi as a material for extracting the potential value of regional income from the contribution of taxes on oil palm plantations and discussing plans for extracting tax potential from oil palm plantations as one of the regional incomes of Central Sulawesi Province.
