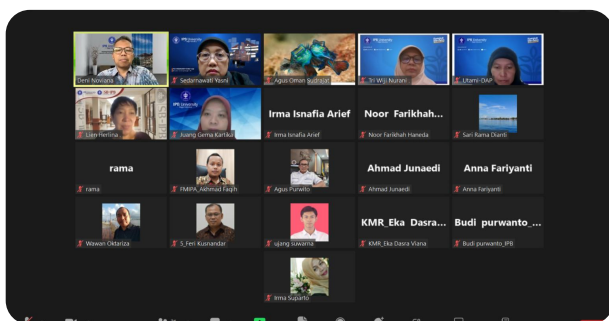

1 Learning Program



IPB University demonstrates its commitment to peace, justice, and strong institutions through flagship educational initiatives. At the forefront is the groundbreaking enrichment course **"Integrity and Anti-Corruption Culture"**, embedded in the university's K2020 curriculum. Developed by the **Anti-Corruption Working Group (Pokja Antikorupsi)** and shaped through extensive consultation with academic leaders, this course nurtures future leaders who uphold honesty, fairness, and accountability. Students internalize these values through experiential learning, case analysis, and national as well as international legal perspectives, complemented by the IPB Integrity Fest, a campus-wide initiative promoting transparency and ethical awareness through creative media.

Justice and peace education is further integrated through the course **"Natural Resources, Justice, and Peace"** within the Communication and Community Development program. This equips students with a profound understanding of resource governance, conflict resolution, and inclusive development, preparing them as agents of ethical transformation in society.



In collaboration with the University of British Columbia (UBC), Canada, IPB organizes the **Impact Evaluation Assessment Summer Course**, a month-long program since 2014. It trains students to evaluate social and environmental impacts of public policies, combining classroom discussion with direct community fieldwork to strengthen skills in transparency, accountability, and evidence-based decision-making. Complementing these international and national initiatives, programs like **Role of Lecturers as Role Models in National Values and Pancasila** ensure that educators embody integrity, fairness, and inclusivity, cultivating a learning culture rooted in humanity, democracy, and social justice. Furthermore, all undergraduate students are required to complete **Pancasila and Citizenship Education courses** for six semesters, instilling a deep understanding of civic ethics, national identity, and responsible citizenship.



Holistic character building is reinforced through the **LPDP IPB Mental Health Program** under the IPB School of Graduate Studies, which provides guidance and seminars for scholarship recipients to maintain mental well-being while pursuing academic excellence. By balancing ambition with empathy and discipline with compassion, IPB underscores that strong institutions begin with resilient, ethical, and self-aware individuals.



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2 Research and Innovation

IPB translates learning into actionable solutions that reinforce good governance, ethical leadership, and justice. Analytical research, such as **Implementation of Inclusive Leadership: The Sundar Pichai Case Study**, equips students with strategies for equitable and participatory decision-making, fostering transparent and accountable institutions



Applied research on crisis management, exemplified by **Kepemimpinan dalam Situasi Krisis – Multihelix Disaster Response**, provides frameworks for coordinated emergency response, linking governance, leadership, and societal resilience. Legal studies, highlighted by **Three IPB Professors Awarded for Environmental Law Enforcement**, strengthen the rule of law, illustrating how academia influences justice and institutional integrity. Technological innovation also enhances institutional efficiency. For instance, **AI-assisted Customer Service Optimization** improves responsiveness and public trust. Achievements such as **QS WUR 2014 recognition for Rapid Employment of Graduates** indirectly reflect institutional quality and societal impact, underscoring IPB's holistic contribution to governance ecosystems.

National recognition, including **Gold Winner by LLDIKTI Region IV** as the Most Inspirational and Most Collaborative State University, confirms the university's effective strategies in stakeholder partnerships and transparent institutional operations.

3 Campus Operation



IPB promotes cultural diversity and heritage through flagship events such as **Gebyar Nusantara (Genus) 2024**, Indonesia's largest cultural festival, recognized by Minister of Tourism and Creative Economy Sandiaga Uno. The festival engaged over 5,000 students, featuring cultural carnivals, culinary competitions, traditional fashion shows, and regional performances, fostering social cohesion and cultural awareness.





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To reinforce integrity and transparency, IPB signed a **Cooperation Agreement (PKS)** with the **Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK)** and inaugurated the KPK Corner at the Dramaga Campus Library. Launched by KPK Chairman Komjen Pol Firli Bahuri, the Corner provides access to over 500 books on integrity and corruption prevention, strengthening anti-corruption literacy among students, lecturers, and staff.



Scholarship programs are managed with transparency and accountability, supported by the **IPB Transparent Reporting System**, ensuring ethical compliance and fairness. On-campus **dormitories** serve not only as housing but also as living laboratories for cultural learning, fostering intercultural competence, tolerance, and peacebuilding among students from diverse backgrounds.

IPB operationalizes SDGs 16 principles through programs such as **TELADAN Leadership Scholarship 2025**, **Regional Representative Scholarships**, and **Pemprov Riau S1-S3 2024 Scholarships**, providing equitable access to quality education and promoting social inclusion, fairness, and leadership development.



Community Engagement



IPB has been appointed by **KPK** as the sole pilot university for Anti-Corruption Education in Indonesia, reflecting its leadership in promoting integrity, ethical governance, and transparency. Initiatives such as the Anti-Corruption Education Capacity Building Program at IICC empower lecturers as agents of change, embedding anti-corruption values across teaching and campus governance.



Programs like **Veteran and Academic Collaboration on Pancasila Implementation and PKKPT 2024 for University Rectors in South Korea** strengthen civic awareness, governance capacity, and transparency.





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Humanitarian actions, including **donations for Palestine** and **HAE Peduli Ramadan Service**, with a total value of approximately Rp 80 Million, demonstrate IPB's commitment to peace and social responsibility beyond borders. Local partnerships, tuition adjustments, and recognition for **gratuity control by KPK** further highlight the university's dedication to accountability, transparency, and sustainable institutional management.



Students also translate knowledge into tangible leadership contributions via the **Leadership Dormitory Program** at **Yayasan Mizan Amanah**, podcasts on women's leadership, the **LIVELET Program – Leadership for Children in Disadvantaged Areas (3T)**, and participation in the **Nusantara Cultural Festival 15**.



Practical leadership experiences are further enhanced through the **MSIB Pertamina Foundation Internship**, connecting theory to real-world governance and organizational management.

Student Activity

Students actively engage in integrity and leadership promotion. The **Campus Integrity Festival**, running from September to December 2022, provided a platform for students to engage in creative anti-corruption campaigns, leveraging performances, social media, and innovative media content.

Through the **Thematic Community Service Program (KKNT) – Innovation Scheme**, students implemented the "Sрати Teaching Integrity" program in Sрати Village, Kebumen, integrating the IPB20H course on Integrity and Anti-Corruption Culture. Activities such as classroom discussions, educational videos, TikTok content, and poster competitions taught elementary to high school students principles of honesty, fairness, responsibility, and care for others.
